

Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

Handy Hints


- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts

a: Insert Cam bolts into top panel as shown


b: Insert Cam bolts finto left frame side and right frame side as shown





Assembly frame side


Insert Cam locks **G**into the shelf panel **5**back rail **7** and top


a: Assembly frame side


Insert Cam locks **G**into the shelf panel **5**back rail **7**, bottom
front rail **6** and top
front rail **4**. Press
firmly together. Turn the
cam lock clockwise with
a philipshead screwdriver
to lock.

Remove cover paper on the pad . Attach the pad into under the legs.






Step 5

Assembly back panel

Insert back panel 9 into the slot of back rail & frame side.



Step 6

Assembly top panel

Insert Cam locks G
into side panel 2 3
as shown .Press top panel
1 onto assembly.Turn cam
locks to lock . Insert bolts
B , Spring washer D ,
flat washer E , Tighten
with supplied allen key C
Do not over tighten.




a: Position Left side
