




# Assembly Advice

Before commencing assembly, we recommend that you familiarise yourself with the component parts list supplied and the instructions. We suggest that you lay out the components and check these against the parts

- Please retain packaging materials until assembly is complete; then dispose of packaging materials carefully
- We recommend that you assemble the product on a soft/carpeted surface to prevent any damage to panels during assembly
- Ensure that all fixings are tight and check these periodically for tightness
- Note: small parts pose a potential safety hazard; ensure that these are securely attached and kept out of reach of children

#### **Important** Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 2 and 3.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.


#### Care and maintenance

- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.







# **Assembly Instructions**

#### Step 1

#### Fixing metal brackets.

Fix metal brackets **1** into the pre drilled holes in the headboard **1** and footboard **2** using screws **3**.




#### Step 2

Assembling centre rail and inserting dowels.

Attach centre rail 4 into the pre drilled holes in the middle support 6 using screws **D**.

Insert dowels **A** into the side rails **3**.



## Assembly Instructions

#### Step 3

Assembling side rails.




#### Important:

Two people are required for an easier assembly.

**a:** Attach centre rail 4 to the metal bracket of headboard using bolt **and nut 1**.


**b:** With help, assemble side rails 3 to headboard using fixings **F G** with the allen key **M** as shown.



#### Step 4

**a:** Attach centre rail 4 to the metal bracket of footboard using bolt and nut **H**.

**b:** With help, assemble side rails 3 to footboard using fixings **G** with the allen key **M** as shown.




### Assembly Instructions

#### Step 5

a: Fix metal studs (into the headboard 1 and footboard 2 at the dimensions shown.

**b:** Fix wooden covers **l** into the holes in the headboard **1** and footboard **2** as shown.

Warning:
While fixing
wooden covers be careful
not to damage them.




#### Step 6

#### Assembling slats.

**a:** Please fix the first slat 5 at the end of the rail and work towards the middle of the bed using the spacer (1) as shown to ensure correct spacing.

**b:** Fix all the slats to the side rails first using screws **©**. After, fix all the slats to the centre rail.

Assembly is complete.
