



1xAdaptor

1.Read these instruction carefully and familiarise yourself with the procedure before assembling the unit.

2.Check that you have all the component parts following the list on the back cover and familiarise yourself with

each part before proceeding.

4. Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly.

5. To avoid scratching it is recommended that you assemble the unit on a soft level surface.

Stage 1 - Fiting the unit

Stage 2 - Adjusting the unit

WARNING: If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

NOTE: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

- 1.Connect the cables from seat cushion to the cables on back rest
 - B, the adaptor and remote control O.

See fig.1.

NOTE: After assembling plug the Adaptor into the mains socket.

Insert the back rest

onto the seat cushion

See fig.2.

NOTE:Carefully align the two side metal locks to ensure correct alignment.


 Engage the metal locks and push fit. You should hear them lock into position.

NOTE:Ensure the cables are not trapped but pushed to the side.

4. Fit the velcro cover flap on the back rest

onto the velcro on the seat cushion
.

NOTE: Connect the adaptor to the mains socket.


Back and Foot Rest Adjustment

This chair features a electronic reclining back rest and raised foot rest. You need to use the up/down button (1) to adjust it.

- Push the up/down button to "Down" Position. The chair will recline and the foot rest will automatically lift up.
 See fig.3.
- 2.Push the up/down button to "Up" Position. The back rest will move forward and the foot rest will lower.

Adjust the recliner to your own requirements.

Stage 3 - Operation

 Press the power button to turn on the unit.

- 2.Use the mode, zone and intensity buttons to control the massage settings to your requirements. See fig.5.
- Press the buttons to scroll through the levels.

CAUTION: As with all massage products always consult your doctor if you are not sure before use. Always unplug the adaptor after use.


