

## USER INSTRUCTIONS FOR GREENHOUSE

### FITTINGS

**IMPORTANT** - Read these instructions carefully and familiarize yourself with the procedure before assembling the unit.

1. Check that you have all the component parts following the list above and familiarize yourself with each part before proceeding.
2. Take all the fittings out of the plastic bag and separate them into their groups.
3. Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly.
4. To avoid scratching it is recommended that you assemble the unit on a soft level surface.
5. Please unclip front door before adding cover to frame.
6. Not suitable for using heater inside or near this product.

### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

#### Step 1-Fitting the frame

**NOTE:** There are many different kinds of Tubes Ensure you check before assembly.

1. Fitting the plastic connectors (J, H) to the metal tubes (A, B, E) and build the main frame as shown on the diagram.
2. Build the unit starting from the base and then layer by layer up to top.

#### Step 2 - Fitting Top Frames & Shelves

1. Fitting the plastic connectors (K) to the metal tubes (F, C, D) and build the Top Frame as shown on the diagram.
2. Insert the top frame onto the main unit.
3. Locate the mesh grill (G) onto the unit.
4. Fit the Roof rib connecting wire (L) to the Top Frames.

**NOTE:** You have to spring out the top frames to fit the roof rib connecting wire.

#### Step 3 - Fitting the Cover

1. Unclip the Cover.
2. Place the Cover onto the frame.
3. The front flap can be clipped open and tied up if required.
4. The cover can be attached to the frame by four ties at the base.
5. Then place the unit in the desired location.

**NOTE:** Locate the unit on flat ground free from obstruction.

**IMPORTANT:** The unit is light weight and should be located in a sheltered place away from wind and heavy rain. Keep the unit away from heat.

### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

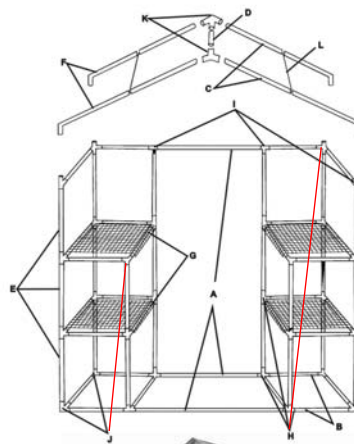
#### Safety

Clean all surfaces with a damp cloth and mild detergent only. Do not use organic cleaning agents, bleach or abrasive products.










