

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.
 Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.



Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws


The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

Step 1

Attaching hinges

a: Use Screws 1 to fix the Door hinges 1 'back plates' onto the Right side panel 4 and Left side panel 5.


Note: Only two screws (not four) are fitted to the door hinge back plate.



b: Screw Locking pins into the Right side panel and Left side panel .

Note: Insert Locking pins as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**

Insert Dowels (a) into the Right side panel (4) and Left side panel (5).



Step 2

Attaching bottom and middle panel

a: Use Screws **(**sto fix Plastic supports **(**) onto the Front panel **(**11).

Note: Be sure the edges of the Plastic supports **①** even with the edges of the Front panel **11**.


b: Use Screws to fix the Front panel 11 onto the Bottom panel 2.

C: Screw Locking pins **(B)** into the Middle panel **(3)**.

Note: Insert Locking pins as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**



d: Use Screws (A) to fix the Middle support (9) onto the Middle panel (3).



e: Use Screws (a) to fix the Right support (b) and Left support (c) onto the Shelf panel (d).

Insert Dowels ② into the Right support ⑤ and Left support 7.




f: Carefully locate the Middle panel 3 onto the unit.

Insert 4 Locking nuts **o** into the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts **O** clockwise to lock.



g: Use Screws (a) to fix Bottom panel (2) onto the unit.

Step 3

Attaching right and left side panel

a: Carefully locate the Left side panel 5 onto the unit.

Insert 4 Locking nuts **o** into the unit.


Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts **①** clockwise to lock.


b: Carefully locate the Right side panel 4 onto the unit.

Step 4

Attaching back panel

a: Insert Dowels **©** into the Back panel **8** .

Use Screws 1 to fix the Back panel 2 onto the Middle panel 3 and Bottom panel 2.


b: With help, carefully stand the unit upright.

Attaching top panel


a: Screw Locking pins **b** into the Top panel **1**.

Note: Insert Locking pins as far as shown. **Do not over tighten.**

b: Carefully locate the Top panel 1 onto the unit.

Insert 8 Locking nuts **o** into the unit.

Use a screwdriver to turn Locking nuts **①** clockwise to lock.




Step 6

Attaching hinges to doors

Fix 4 Door hinges (1) to Left door panel 13 and Right door panel 12 using Screws (1).

Tear off the protective backing from the Door Pads **©** .

Carefully stick the Door pads **©** onto the Left door panel **13** and Right door panel **12**.






Hanging doors


a: With help, Mount the doors by clipping the hinge arms onto the mounting plates.

b: Press the hinge **H** end button to unclip the door if need be .




Step 8

Finishing the unit

Note: It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

With help, place the unit in the intended position.



Fittings-Hinges

a: You will need to support the weight of the doorduring this process. If the door is close to the ground this can be achieved by using blocks orsimilar. Otherwise a second person may be required to assist.

Loosen, but do not remove the top and bottom screws on all hinge mounting plates.


b: Try to work on the hinges one at a time. This will prevent the weight of the door pulling it out of position.


C: This method can also be used to straighten-up tilting or twisting doors.


Try to work on the hinges one at a time. Gradually adjusting and checking to see what changes each adjustment makes.

If you are finding the screw difficult to turn it may help to slightly loosen the rear screw, retightening after.

Assembly is complete.
