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Safety and Care Advice

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on page 2.
 - Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
 - Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
 - Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
 - Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
 - Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
 - Assemble the unit as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
 - Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
 - If using power tools, please follow the safety instructions supplied with the tools.
 - This product is for domestic use.
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- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.
 - Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
 - Warning: The unit weights approximately 16 kgs.

Please lift with care.













Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

- Don't fully tighten all screws until assembly is complete.
- Make sure each screw matches the corresponding figure to ensure correct assembly.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1

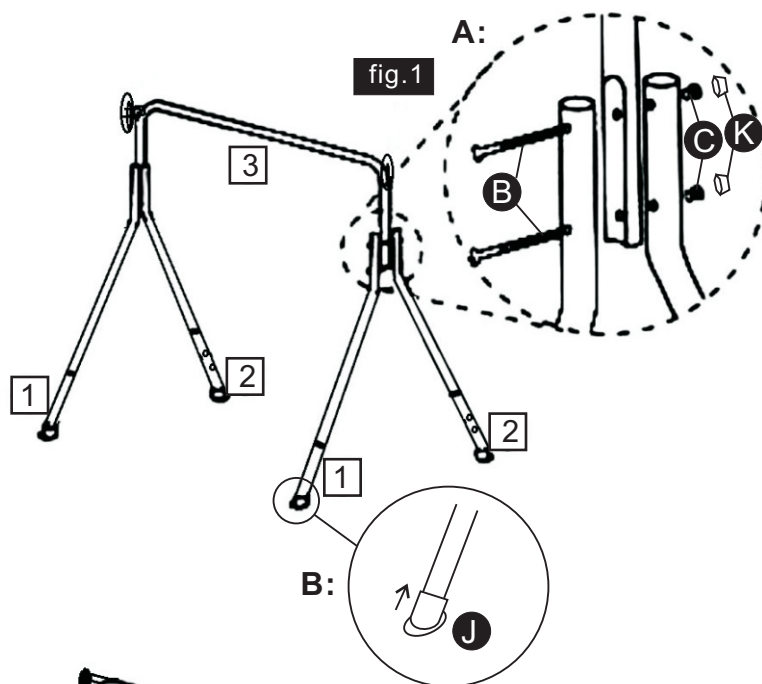
2 person required

A: Fix front leg **1**, upper connect tube **3** and rear leg **2** together using bolts **B** washers and nuts **C**.

B: Fix the feet **J** to the legs.

FULLY TIGHTEN ALL NUTS.

Then use nut covers **K** to cover the nuts (See fig .1)

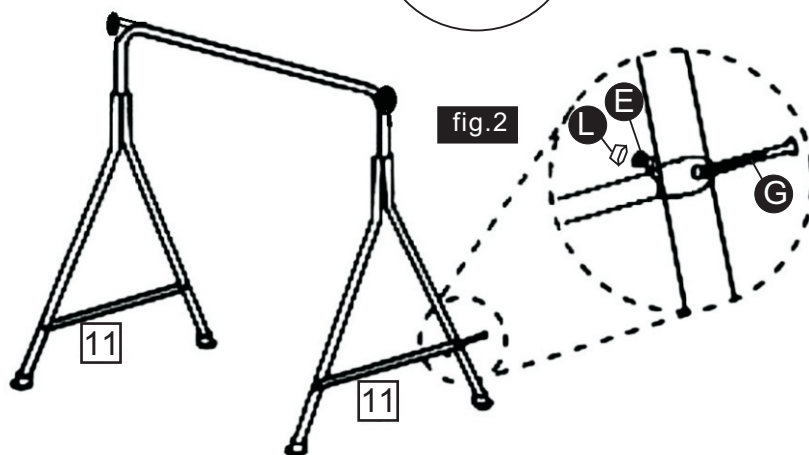


Step 2

Fix side connect tube **11** between front leg **1** and rear leg **2** using bolts **G**, washers and nuts **E**.

FULLY TIGHTEN ALL NUTS.

Then use nut covers **L** to cover the nuts (See fig .1)

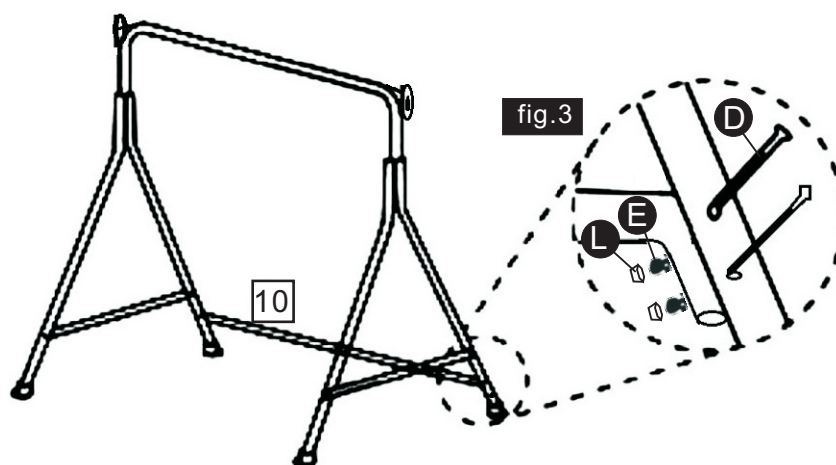


Step 3

Fix lower connect tube **10** between two rear legs **2** using bolts **D**, washers and nuts **E**.

FULLY TIGHTEN ALL NUTS.

Then use nut covers **L** to cover the nuts (See fig .3)



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Assembly Instructions

Step 4

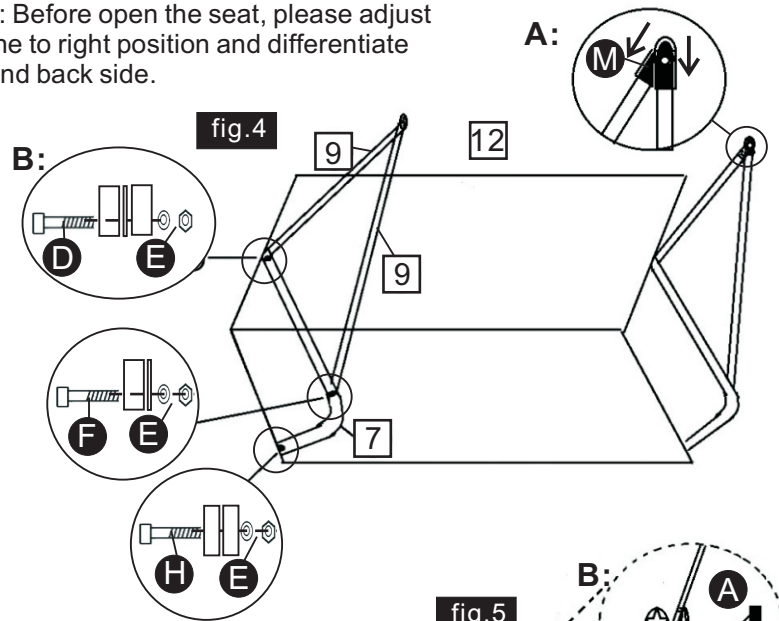
A: Cap the both ends of the hanging tubes **9** by plastic sleeve **M**.

B: Fix the armrest **7** and hanging tubes **9** to the seat **12** using bolts **D**, **F**, **H**, washers and nuts **E**.

FULLY TIGHTEN ALL NUTS.

Then use nut covers **L** to cover the nuts (See fig .4)

⚠ Important: Before open the seat, please adjust the textiene to right position and differentiate the seat and back side.

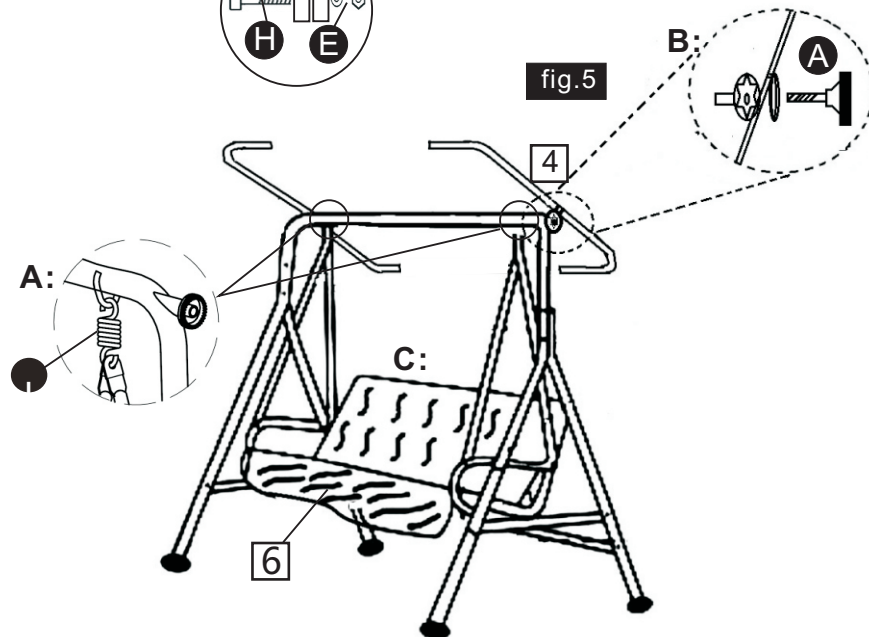


Step 5

A: Use spring hook **1** to hang the seat, then put seat cushion **6** on the seat.

B: Use plastic switch **A** to fix the canopy U shape tube **4** to the both sides of the upper connect tube. (See fig .5)

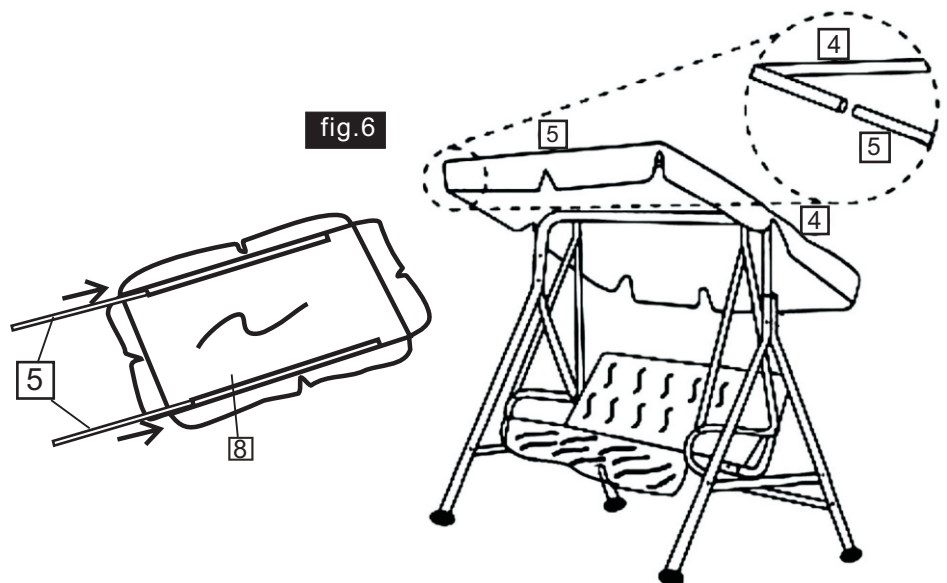
C: Put the seat cushion **6** to the seat **12** and fixed by bendage.



Step 6

Insert the canopy tube **5** to the canopy **8** then connect it to the canopy U shape tube **4**.
