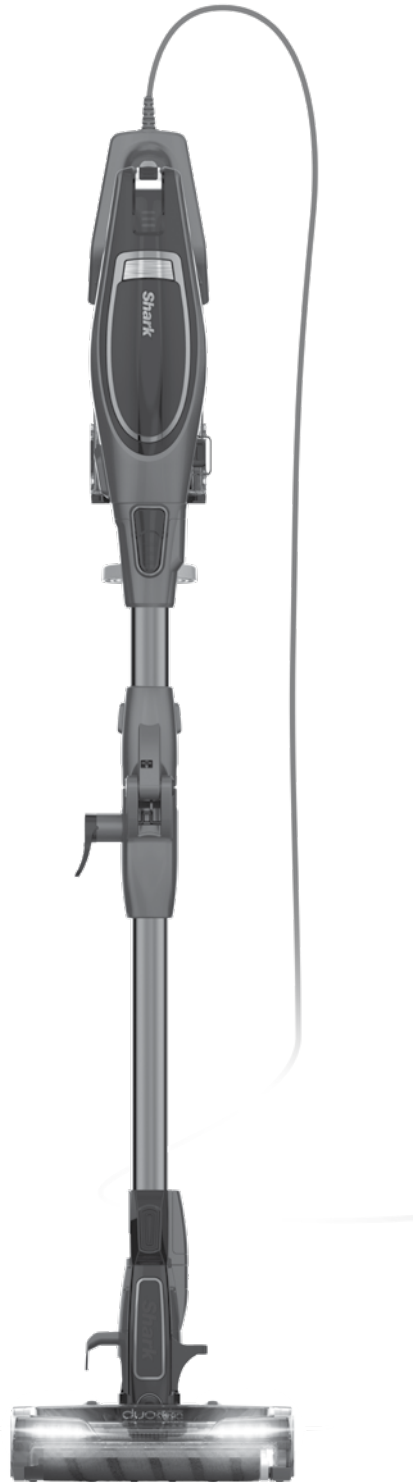

CAUTION: THE MOTORISED FLOOR NOZZLE, WAND, AND HANDHELD VACUUM CONTAIN ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS:

- These are **NOT** serviceable parts.
- **DO NOT** use to suck up water.
- **DO NOT** immerse in water when cleaning.
- The handle/wand should be checked regularly and must not be used if damaged.

- 1** Inspect power cord and plug for any damage before use. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by SharkNinja Operating LLC, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard. **DO NOT** use vacuum cleaner with a damaged cord or plug. Turn off all controls before plugging in or unplugging the vacuum cleaner. Store your vacuum cleaner with the supply cord secured around the two cord hooks.
- 2 DO NOT** use outdoors or on wet surfaces. Use only on dry surfaces.
- 3** The plug must be removed from the socket-outlet before cleaning or maintaining the appliance.
- 4** If vacuum cleaner is not working as it should, or has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or immersed in water, return it to Euro-Pro Europe Ltd for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- 5 DO NOT** pull or carry vacuum cleaner by the cord or use the cord as a handle.

- 6 DO NOT** unplug by pulling on cord. Grasp the plug, **NOT** the cord.
- 7 DO NOT** handle plug or vacuum cleaner with wet hands.
- 8 DO NOT** run the vacuum cleaner over the power cord, close a door on the cord, or pull the cord around sharp corners.
- 9** The use of an extension cord is **NOT** recommended.
- 10 DO NOT** leave vacuum cleaner unattended when plugged in.
- 11** Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- 12 ALWAYS** turn off this appliance before connecting or disconnecting motorized nozzle.

GENERAL USE

- 13** Use only as described in this manual.
- 14** Keep your work area well lit.
- 15** Keep the vacuum cleaner moving over the carpet surface at all times to avoid damaging the carpet fibres.
- 16 DO NOT** place vacuum cleaner on unstable surfaces such as chairs or tables.
- 17 DO NOT** put any objects into openings. **DO NOT** use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce airflow.
- 18 DO NOT** allow the appliance to be used by children. Close attention is necessary when used near children. This is not a toy.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USE

- 19 DO NOT** use without brushroll, Soft Roller, dust cup, and all filters in place.
- 20 DO NOT** use if airflow is restricted; if the air paths or the motorised floor nozzle become blocked, turn the vacuum cleaner off and unplug from electrical outlet. Remove all obstructions before you turn on the unit again.
- 21** Keep nozzle away from hair, face, fingers, uncovered feet, or loose clothing.
- 22** Only use manufacturer's recommended attachments.

DUST CUP/FILTERS/ACCESSORIES

Before turning on the vacuum:

- 23** Make sure brushroll, Soft Roller, dust cup, and all filters are in place after routine maintenance.
- 24** Make sure Soft Roller, dust cup, and all filters are in place after routine maintenance.
- 25** Make sure accessories are free of blockages and keep openings away from face and body.
- 26** Use only Shark® brand filters and accessories. Using other brands will void warranty.

GENERAL CLEANING

- 27 DO NOT** vacuum up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws, or coins that could damage the vacuum cleaner.
- 28 DO NOT** vacuum up drywall dust, fireplace ash, or embers. **DO NOT** use as an attachment to power tools for dust collection.
- 29 DO NOT** vacuum up smoking or burning objects such as hot coals, cigarette butts, or matches.
- 30 DO NOT** vacuum up flammable or combustible materials (e.g., lighter fluid, gasoline, or kerosene) or use vacuum in areas where they may be present.
- 31 DO NOT** vacuum up toxic solutions (e.g., chlorine bleach, ammonia, or drain cleaner).
- 32 DO NOT** use in an enclosed space where vapours are present from paint, paint thinner, moth-proofing substances, flammable dust, or other explosive or toxic materials.
- 33 DO NOT** vacuum up any liquids.
- 34 DO NOT** immerse vacuum cleaner in water or other liquids.
- 35** Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.

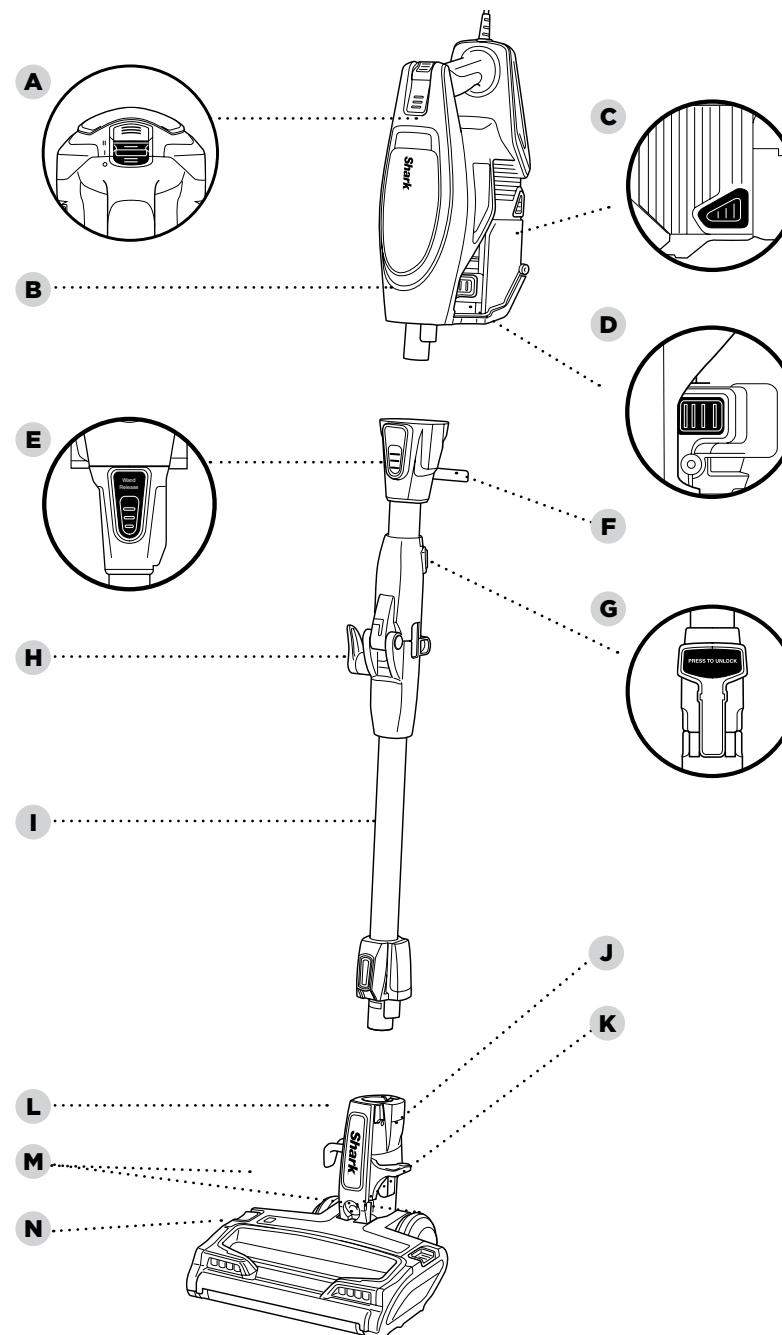

ASSEMBLING YOUR VACUUM

⚠ WARNING: This vacuum does not stand up on its own. Using the unit when it lacks stability may result in personal injury. To place in Flexology™ Storage mode, press the Flexology™ Lock Release Button and gently fold the handheld vacuum forward toward the floor nozzle.

NOTE: Before vacuuming your delicate area rugs or carpet, refer to the manufacturer's recommended cleaning instructions.

WHAT DOES THE BRUSHROLL INDICATOR LIGHT MEAN?

Solid Green

The brushrolls are on and working as they should.

Solid Red

There is a jam in the brushroll area. Turn your vacuum off and remove the blockage.

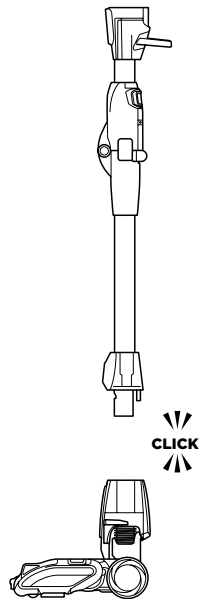
No Light

The brushrolls are not spinning.

DID YOU KNOW?

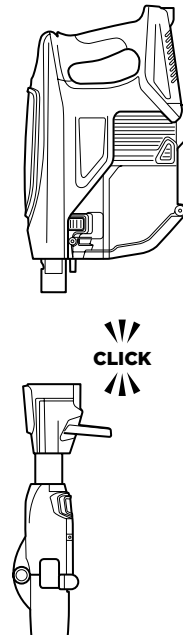
The motorised floor nozzle has LED headlights that illuminate the floor surface being cleaned. The lights turn on automatically in either speed setting.

STEP 1



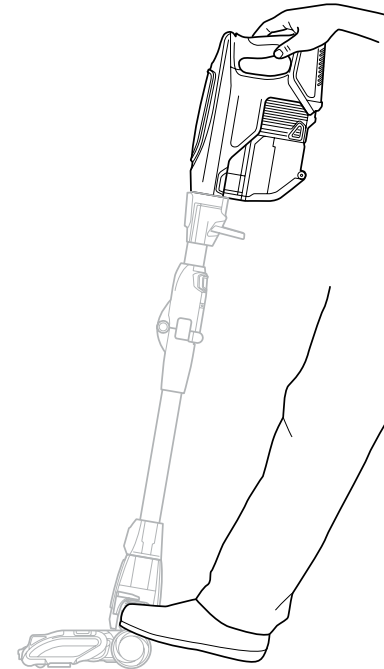
- 1 Insert the wand into the motorised floor nozzle connector, pressing it in until it clicks securely into place.

STEP 2



- 2 Insert the handheld vacuum into the top of the wand, pressing it in until it clicks securely into place.

USING THE MOTORISED FLOOR NOZZLE



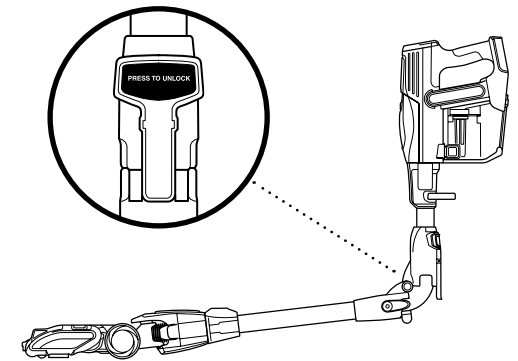
- 1 Slide the Power/Selector Switch to one of the 3 settings:

Setting 0: Turns off power.

Setting I: For cleaning hard floors and area rugs.

Setting II: For cleaning thick pile carpets.

To start cleaning, recline wand to activate brushrolls.



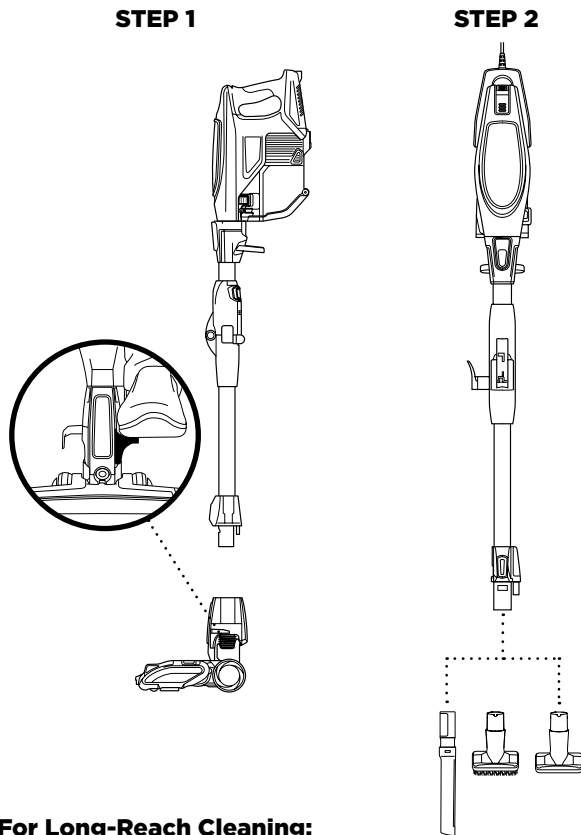
USING THE MULTIFLEX™ WAND

To easily access hard-to-reach areas under furniture, press the Flexology™ Lock Release Button to position the wand to a lower angle.

USING YOUR VACUUM IN ABOVE-FLOOR MODE

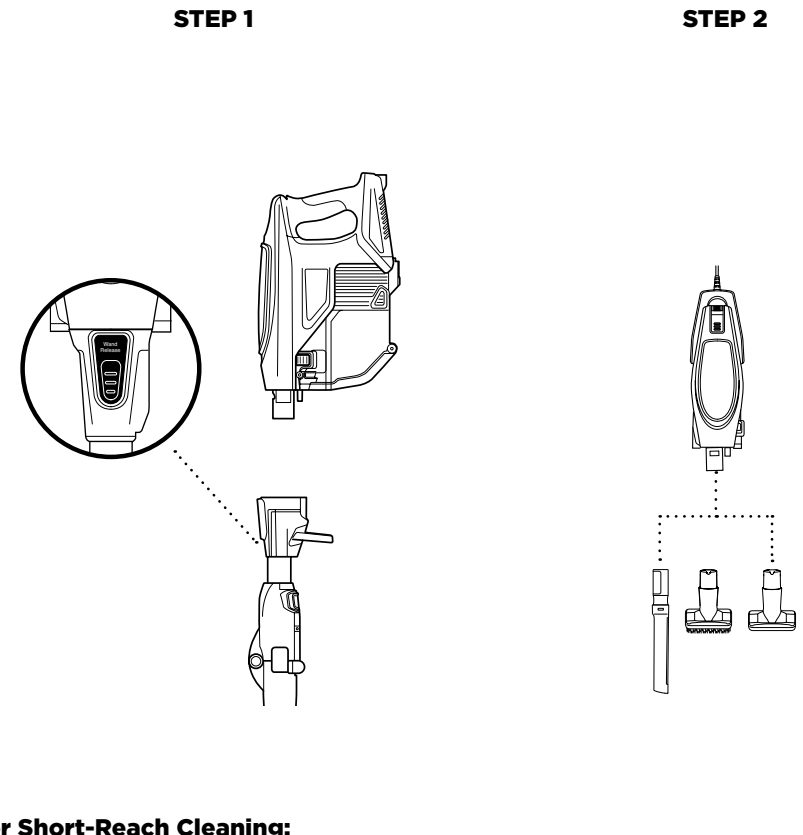
NOTE: Both power settings provide the same suction power.

TIP: You can attach the handheld vacuum directly to the motorised floor nozzle for convenient stair cleaning.



For Long-Reach Cleaning:

- 1 Stand the vacuum upright. Step on the foot pedal and pull the wand up to disconnect it from the motorised floor nozzle.
- 2 Attach desired cleaning accessory to the wand. Press Flexology™ button to vacuum with wand at an angle.



For Short-Reach Cleaning:

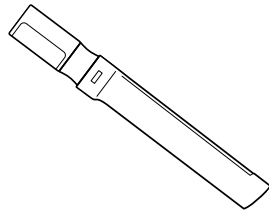
- 1 Press the Wand Release button on the top of the wand to disconnect it from the handheld vacuum.
- 2 Attach desired cleaning accessory or motorised floor nozzle to the handheld vacuum.

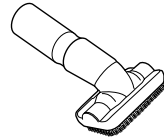

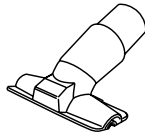
A Crevice Tool

Clean tight spaces or reach skirting boards and ceilings with this slim crevice tool.



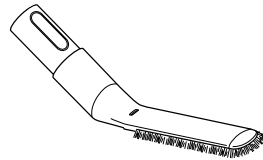
B Dusting Brush

Great for dusting a multitude of surfaces such as shelves, skirting boards, window frames, and more.



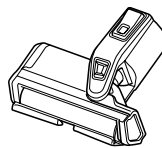
C Upholstery Tool

Perfect for large-particle pickup, dusting, and removing pet hair and lint from furniture and other upholstered surfaces.



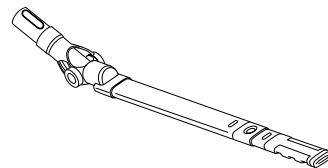
D Anti-Allergen Dust Brush

Nylon fibre bristles specially designed for removing fine dust and allergen particles from the most delicate surfaces.



E Deep-Cleaning Motorised Pet Tool


Motorised compact brush powerful enough to remove deeply embedded allergens, dirt, and hair from multiple surfaces.

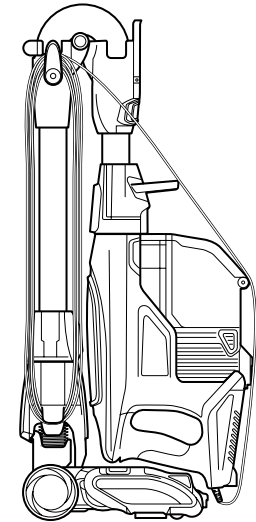


F Under Appliance Wand

Pivoting wand that extends to clean under appliances and on top of furniture.

STORAGE

 **TIP:** The carry handle located below the handheld vacuum can also be used to assist in taking the vacuum in and out of Flexology™ Storage mode.



- 1 Looking at the vacuum from the side with the cord hooks, wrap the power cord anti-clockwise around the hooks, starting under the bottom hook. Then press the Flexology™ Wand Lock Release button and gently fold the handheld vacuum forward toward the floor nozzle. Use the handle to carry the vacuum to its storage location.

To take the vacuum out of storage mode, press the Flexology™ Wand Lock Release button while lifting up the handheld vacuum. When straightened, the wand will lock in place.

MAINTAINING YOUR VACUUM

⚠ WARNING: To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn off power and unplug unit before servicing.

⚠ WARNING: Hand wash filters only with water to prevent damage from cleaning chemicals. Allow ALL filters to air-dry completely before replacing them in the vacuum to prevent liquid from being drawn into electric parts.

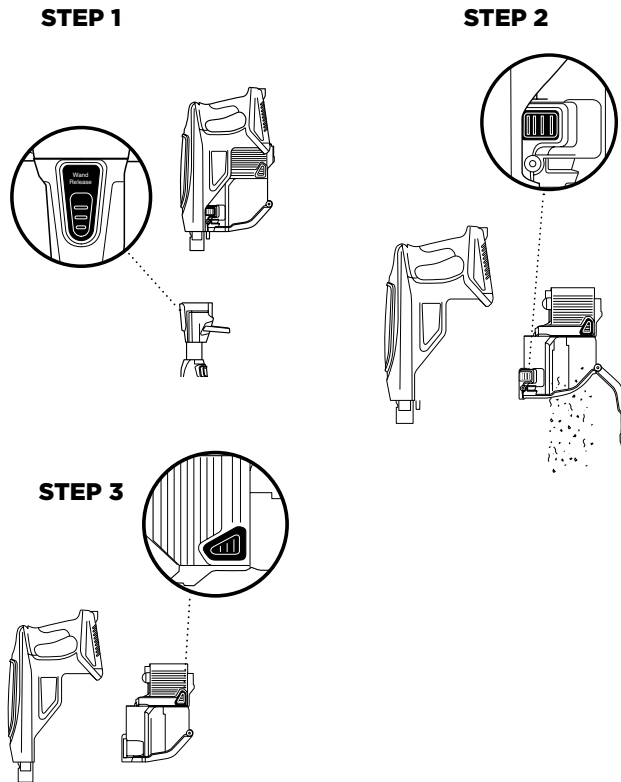
★ IMPORTANT: Clean the dust screen inside the dust cup as required.

NOTE: Empty dust cup when debris reaches the MAX fill line.

RECOMMENDED FILTER CLEANING SCHEDULE:

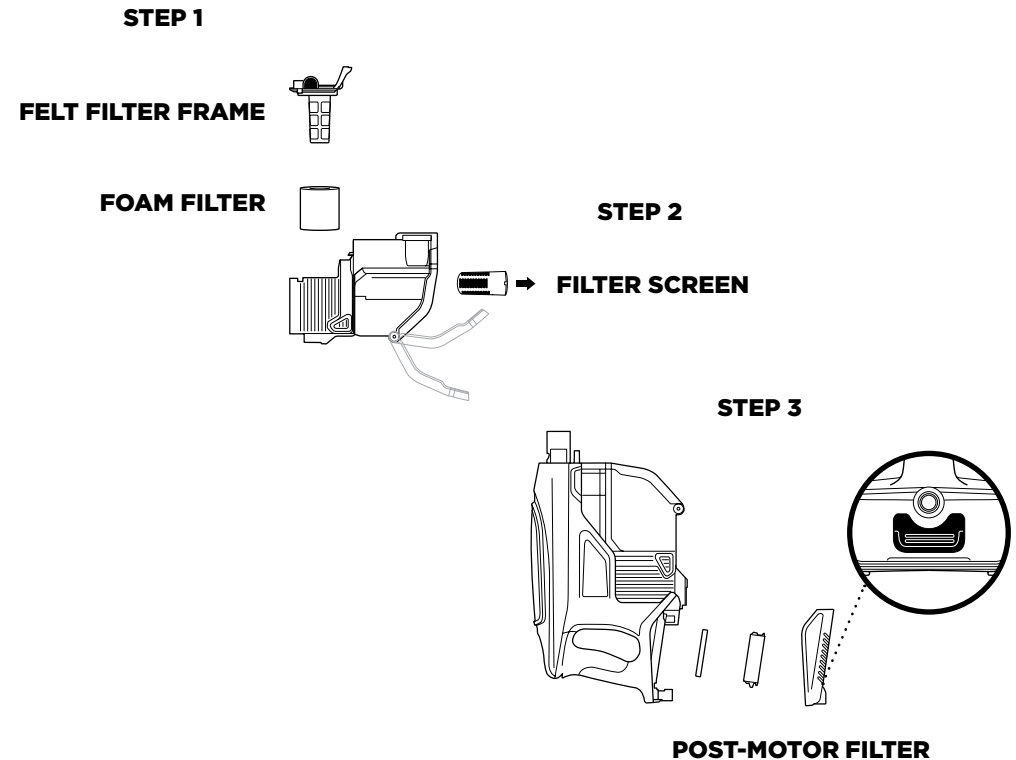
Pre-Motor Filter Kit
(Foam & Felt)
Clean once a month.

Post-Motor Filter
Clean every 9 months.



EMPTYING THE DUST CUP

- 1 Disconnect the handheld vacuum by pressing the Wand Release button on the top of the wand.
- 2 To remove the dust cup from the handheld vacuum, squeeze the two Dust Cup Release buttons on either side of the base then pull out.
- 3 Hold dust cup over a bin and press the Empty button on the front of the dust cup. Close the bottom lid and insert dust cup back into handheld vacuum, pressing it until it clicks.



CLEANING THE FILTERS

- 1 Access the pre-motor filter by removing the dust cup from the vacuum. Separate foam filter from felt filter frame and rinse them with water. **DO NOT** use soap. Tap loose dirt off filters as needed. Allow filters to air-dry completely, then reinsert them and reattach the dust cup to the vacuum.
- 2 Press the Empty button to open the door then pull the screen to remove from dust cup. Remove any hair or debris that may be wrapped around it and tap off dirt as needed. To replace push firmly back in place.
- 3 Access the Post-Motor filter under the handle. Remove the filter and rinse it with water. **DO NOT** use soap.

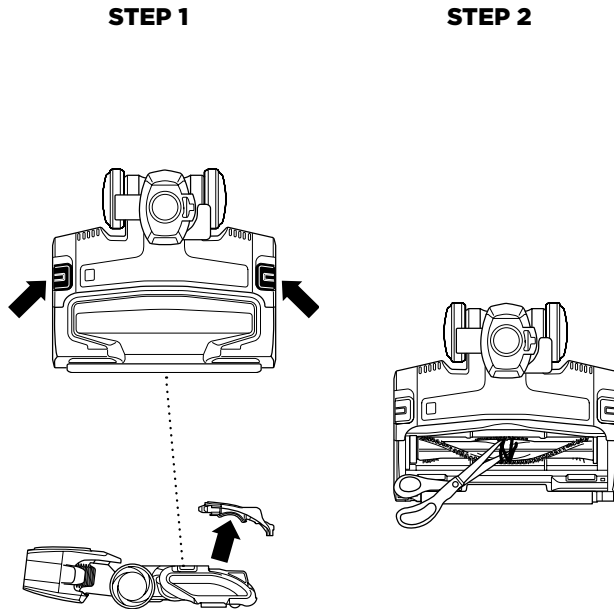
MAINTAINING YOUR VACUUM - CONT.

⚠ WARNING: To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn off power and unplug unit before servicing.

⚠ WARNING: When cleaning brushroll, be sure to not cut anything other than hair, string, fibres, or other debris.

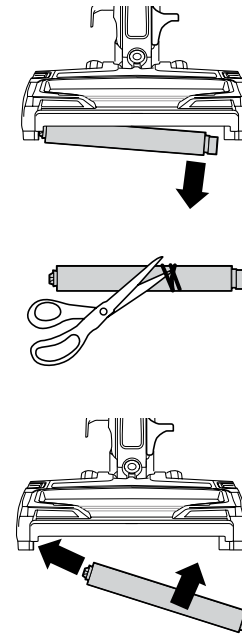
💡 TIP: If nozzle headlights are flashing, then the brushroll garage is not completely closed. Ensure the garage is completely closed by pressing down firmly on both sides.

NOTE: Heavy usage over time may require minimal upkeep to maintain your vacuum's appearance.



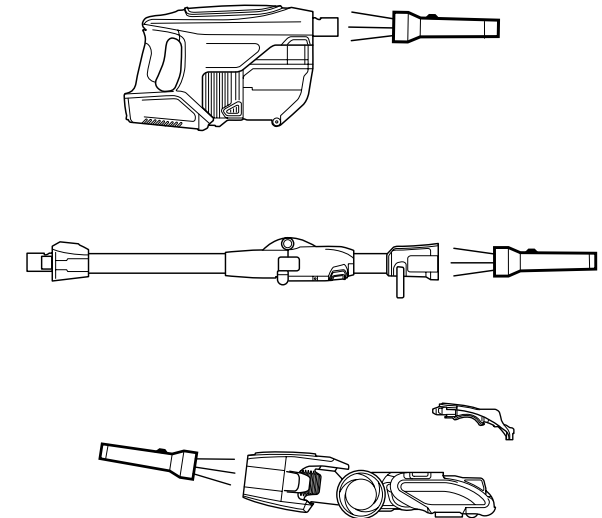
MAINTAINING THE BRUSHROLL

- 1 Open the brushroll lid by sliding both release buttons away from you, toward the back of the nozzle, then lifting off the lid. Remove any string, hair, or debris that may be wrapped around the brushroll by running scissors along the guide on the brushroll.
- 2 Press down on both sides of the lid until it clicks into place.



MAINTAINING THE SOFT ROLLER

- 1 Open the brushroll by sliding both release buttons away from you, toward the back of the nozzle, then lifting off the lid. Lift out the Soft Roller by the tab on the right side. Clean off any string, carpet fibres, or hair that may be wrapped around the Soft Roller. Remove debris from the roller housing.
- 2 Wash the Soft Roller as needed, using only water. Air-dry completely for at least 24 hours before returning it to the brushroll garage.
- 3 Reinsert the Soft Roller by sliding it into the front of the nozzle until it clicks into place. Close the brushroll garage by inserting the tabs on the lid into the slots, then pressing down on both sides of the lid until it clicks into place.



CHECKING FOR BLOCKAGES: HANDHELD, WAND, AND FLOOR NOZZLE

- 1 Remove the wand from the handheld vacuum and check all intake openings on the dust cup.
- 2 Remove the floor nozzle from the wand and check the wand for blockages.
- 3 Tilt neck of floor nozzle back to straighten the airway, then remove blockages.

⚠ WARNING: To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn off power and unplug unit before servicing.

Vacuum is not picking up debris. No suction or light suction. (Refer to Maintenance section for more information.)

- Check filters to see if they need cleaning. Follow instructions for rinsing and completely air-drying the filters before reinserting into the vacuum.
- Dust cup may be full; empty dust cup.
- Check floor nozzle for blockages; clear blockages if required.
- Remove any string, carpet fibres, or hair that may be wrapped around the brushroll and Soft Roller or trapped behind the Soft Roller.

Vacuum lifts area rugs.

- Suction is powerful. Take care when vacuuming area rugs or rugs with delicately sewn edges.
- Turn off the unit to disengage the brushroll and restart with the Power/Selector slider switch.

Brushroll/Soft Roller does not spin.

- If Brushroll Indicator Light on the floor nozzle turns red, the brushroll and/or Soft Roller have stopped spinning. Immediately turn off and unplug vacuum and remove blockage before reconnecting and turning vacuum back on.
- If Brushroll Indicator Light on the floor nozzle is green, the blockage has been successfully cleared. If the light is still red, please contact Customer Service on 0800 862 0453.
- If nozzle LED headlights are flashing, this means the brushroll garage is not completely closed. Turn off and unplug the vacuum. Ensure the brushroll garage is closed by inserting the tabs on the lid into the slots, then pressing down on both sides of the lid until it clicks into place.

Vacuum turns off on its own.

This vacuum is equipped with a motor-protective thermostat so the vacuum will shut off if it overheats. Should this occur, perform the following steps to restart the motor-protective thermostat:

1. Turn off vacuum and unplug it.
2. Empty dust cup and clean filters (see Maintenance section).
3. Check for blockages in hose, accessories, and inlet openings.
4. Allow unit to cool for a minimum of 45 minutes.
5. Plug in vacuum and turn it on.

- Date you purchased the machine (receipt or delivery note)

IMPORTANT

- Both the 12 months and the extended 4 years guarantee will only cover your product from the date of purchase.
- Please keep your receipt at all times. Should you need to use your extended guarantee we will need your receipt to verify the information you have supplied to us is correct. The inability to produce a valid receipt may invalidate your guarantee.

What are the benefits of registering my free Shark guarantee?

What is covered by the free Shark guarantee?

Repair or replacement of your Shark machine (at Shark's discretion), including all parts and labour. A Shark guarantee is in addition to your legal rights as a consumer.

What is not covered by the free Shark guarantee?

- Blockages – For details of how to unblock your vacuum cleaner, please refer to the Operating Manual.
- Normal wear and tear such as brush bar, fuse, belt, batteries etc.
- Accidental damage, faults caused by negligent use or care, misuse, neglect, careless operation or handling of the vacuum cleaner which is not in accordance with the Shark Operating Manual supplied with your machine.
- Use of the vacuum cleaner for anything other than normal domestic household purposes.
- Use of parts not assembled or installed in accordance with the operating instructions.
- Use of parts and accessories which are not Shark Genuine Components.
- Faulty installation (except where installed by Shark).
- Repairs or alterations carried out by parties other than Shark or its agents.
