- Set Output to Headphones to All Audio
- Set Volume Control (Headphones) level to maximum
- Select Adjust Microphone Level and follow the on-screen instructions to calibrate your microphone

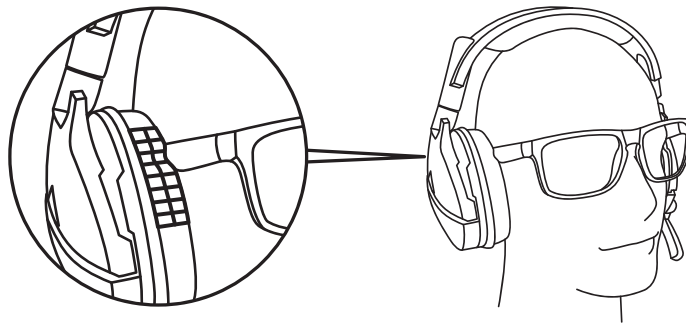

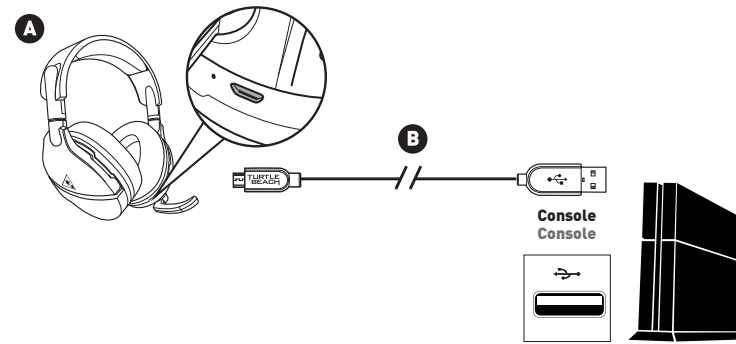

Always charge your headset before storing it for any extended period of time (greater than 3 months). Never store the unit in temperatures above 113°F/45°C.

Etiquette :

- Remove the left ear pad, start by pulling the ear pad straight up using your thumb.
- Once you've released the cloth from the lip on top, pull the ear pad straight back and it should slip right off.
