Step 12

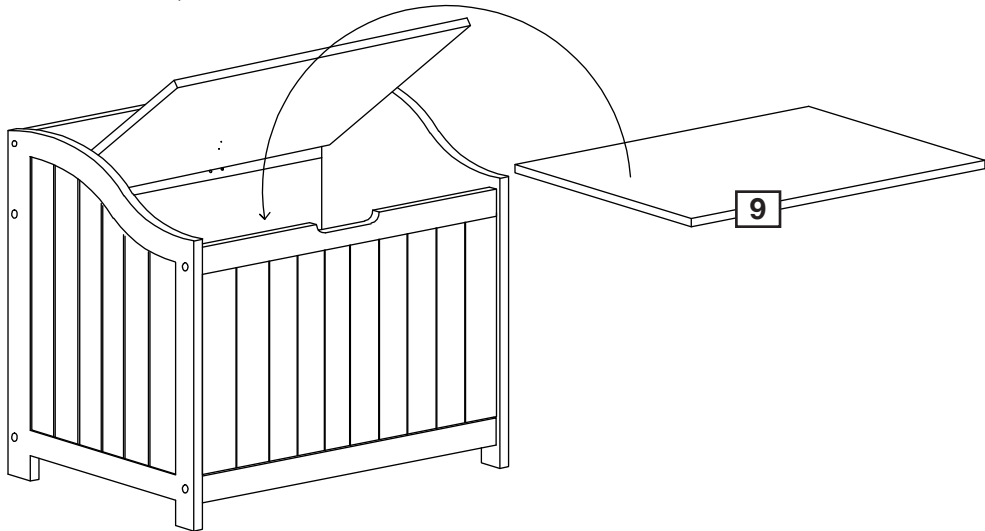
Screw the right side panel **6** the ends of the rails using 5 x 40mm screw **B** as shown.

Ensure that the right-hand hinge of the lid is properly located in its hole in the right side panel.



Step 13

Drop the base panel **9** onto the bottom rails inside the unit.



Step 14

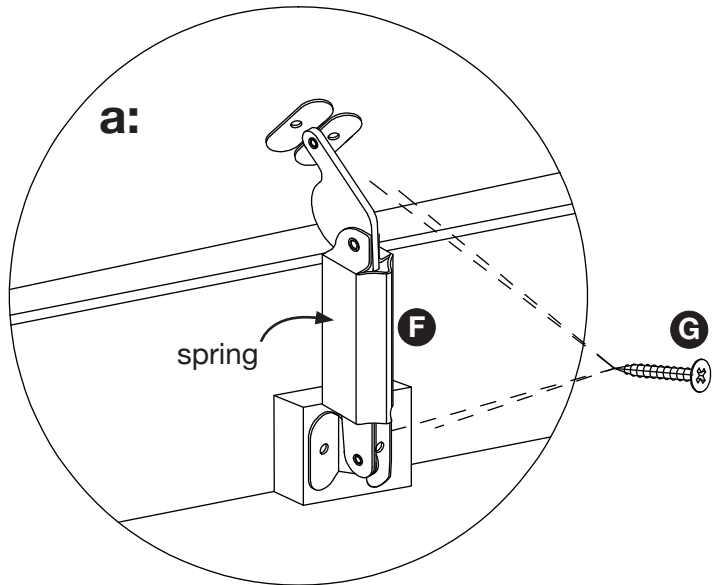
Lift the lid and connect the hinge **F** to the lid and the top back rail as shown using 4 x 12mm screw **G**.



Important:
The hinge must be attached the correct way up.

Please pay attention to diagram **a:** for correct installation.

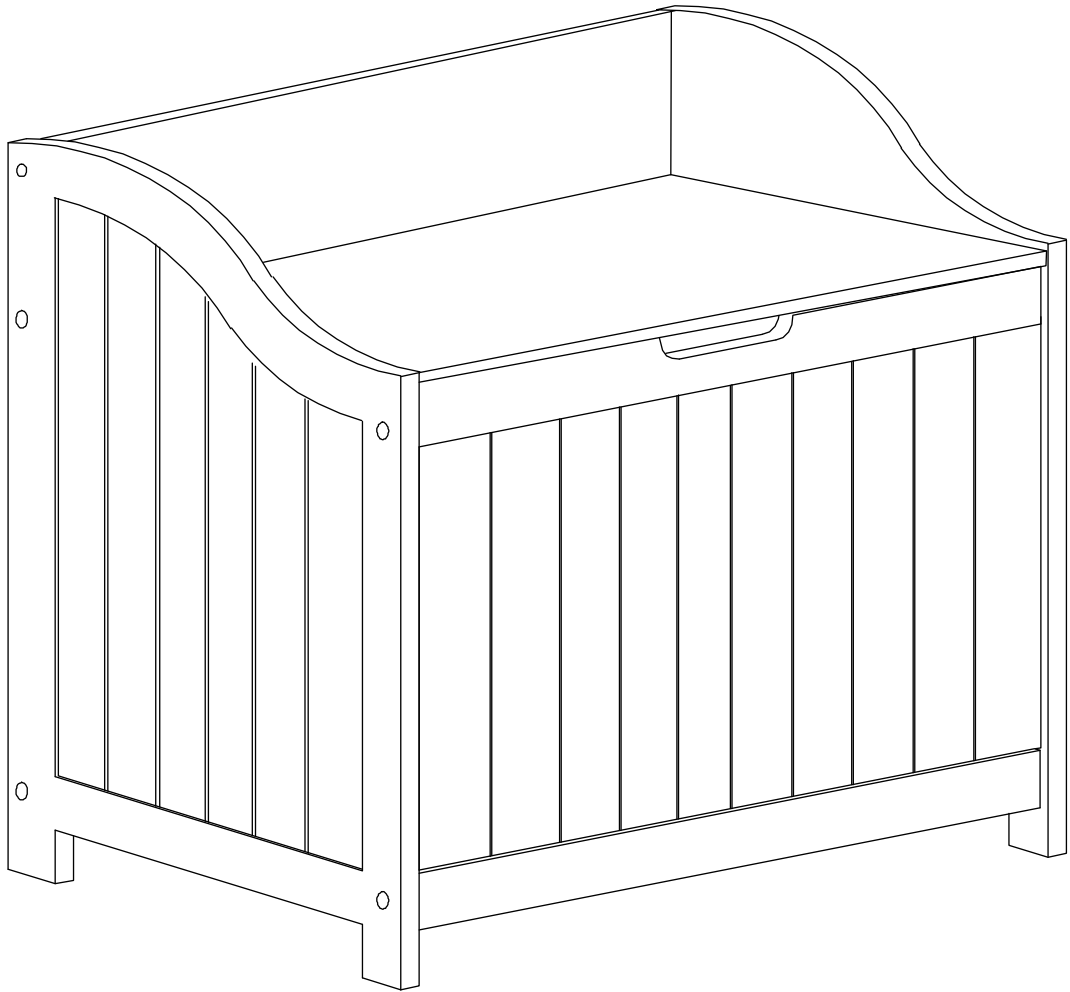

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on pages 1 and 2.

- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Care and maintenance

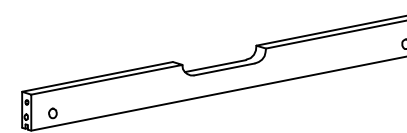
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

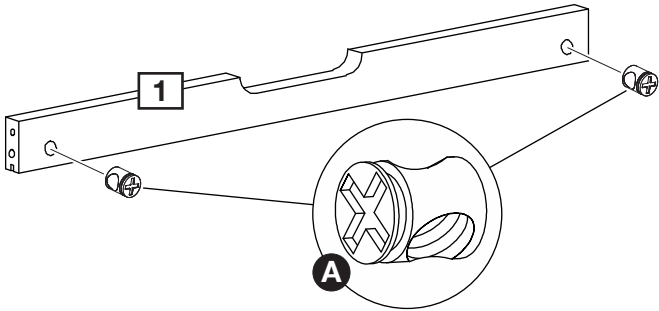
Ruler – Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

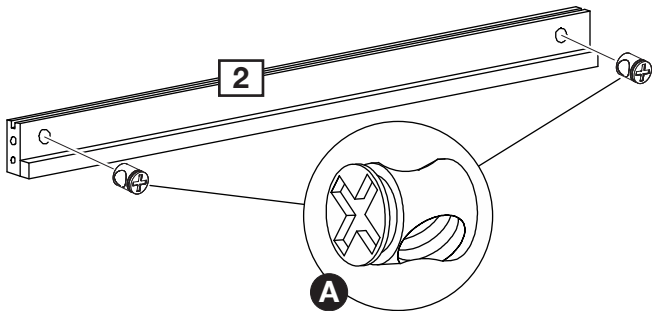
Step 1

Insert 2 x connector **A** into the holes in the front top rail **1** as shown.



Step 2

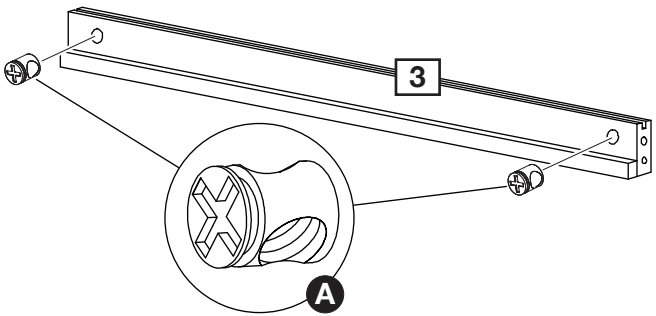
Insert 2 x connector **A** into the holes in the bottom back rail **2** as shown.

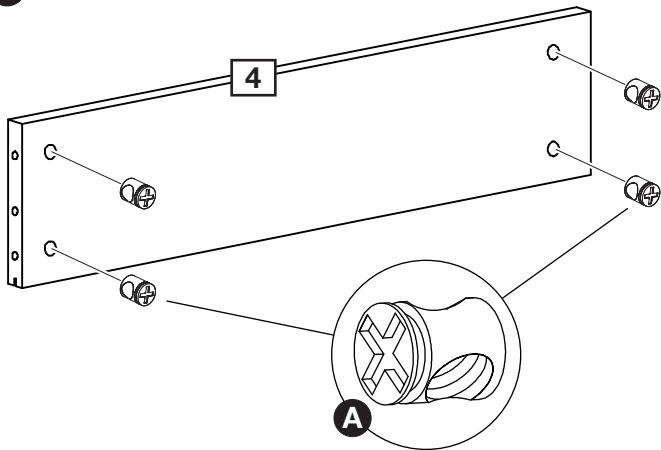
Step 3

Insert 2 x connector **A** into the holes in the bottom front rail **3** as shown.



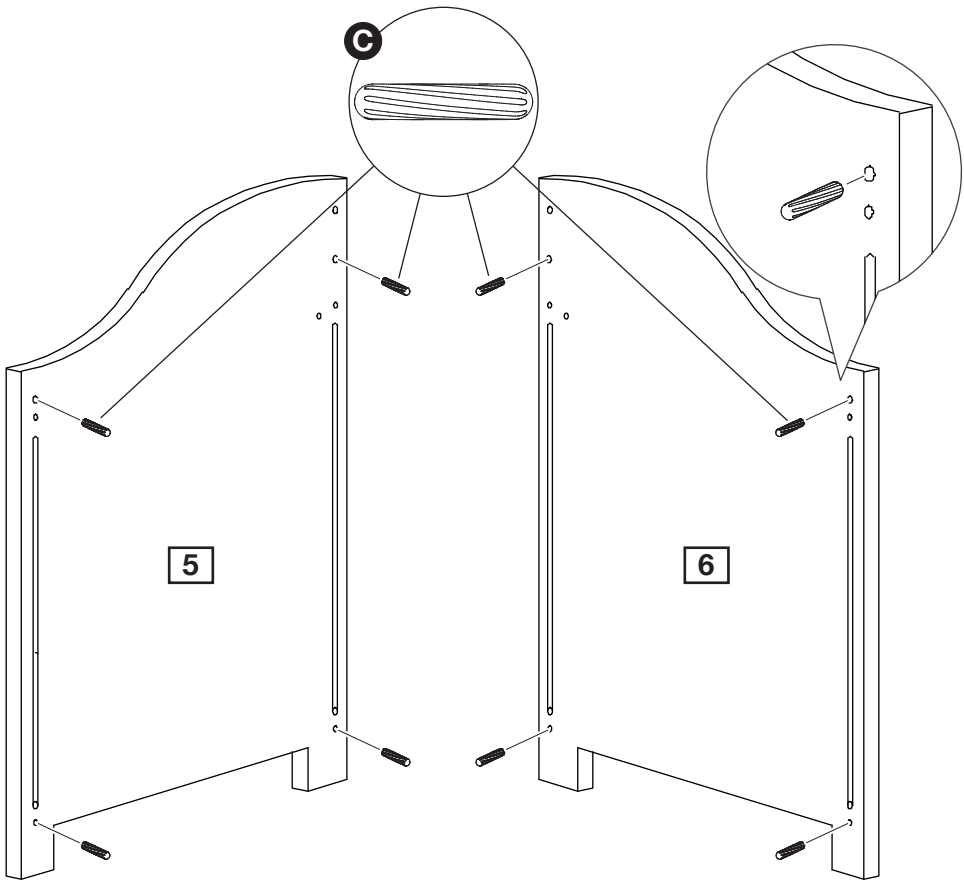
Step 4

Insert 4 x connector **A** into the holes in the top back rail **4** as shown.



Step 5

Insert 4 x 30mm dowel **C** into the left side panel **5** and right side panel **6** as shown.

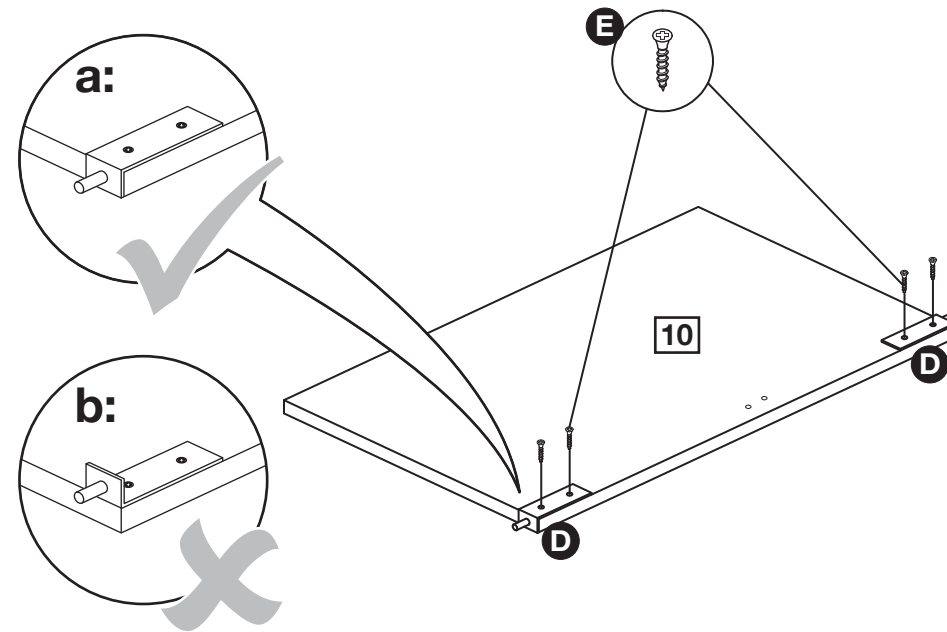
Step 6

Screw both the hinges **D** to the lid **10** using 4 x 12mm screw **E**.

Important: the hinge must fit flush to the edge of the lid (**a**).

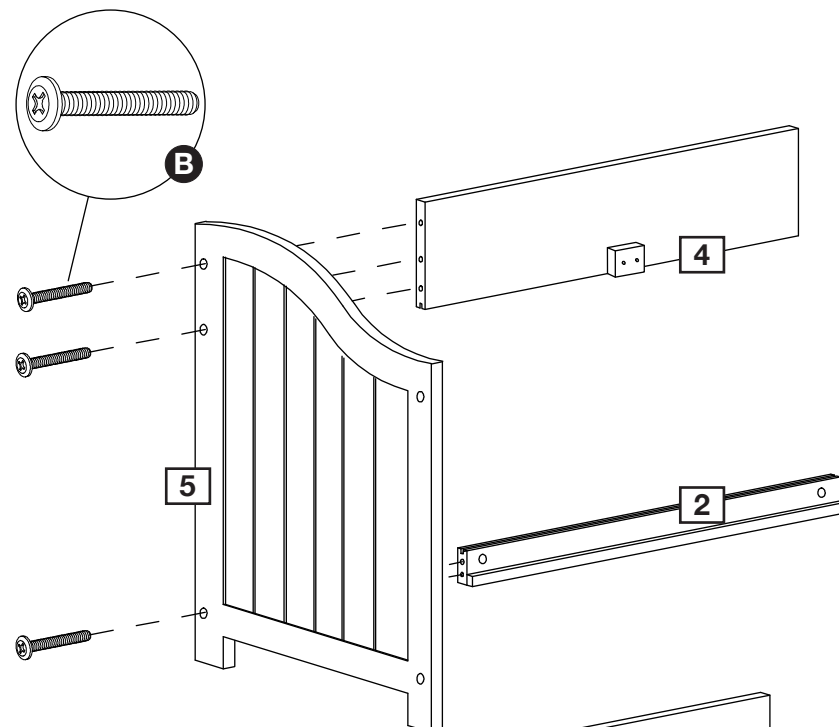
If the hinge post protrudes from the lid as shown (**b**), the lid will not fit the linen bin.

Important: when fitting metal hinges to lid, fit both screws **E** before tightening either of them.



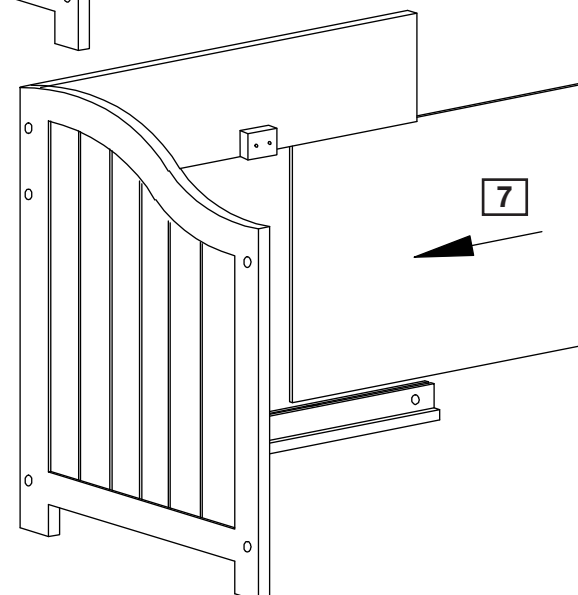
Step 7

Screw the top back rail **4** and the bottom back rail **2** to the left side panel **5** using 3 x 40mm screw **B**.



Step 8

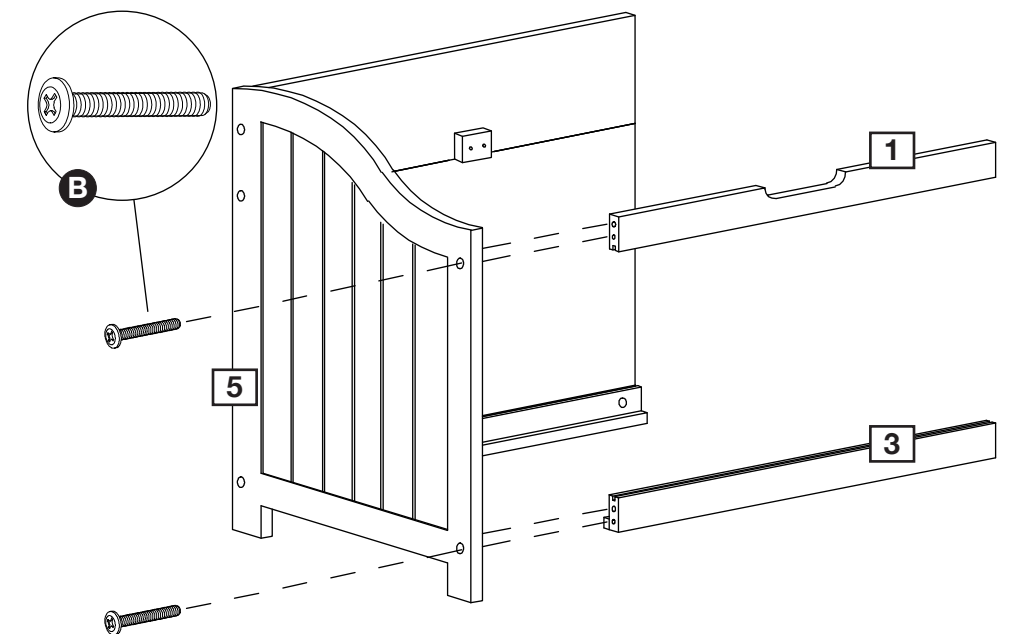
Slide the back panel **7** into the slots of the two back rails.

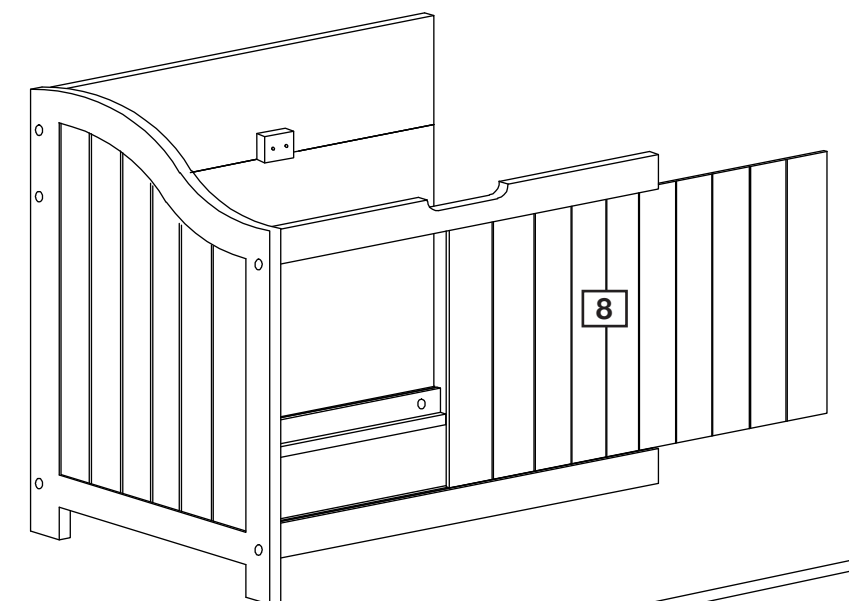
Step 9

Screw the top front rail **1** and the bottom front rail **3** to the left side panel **5** using 2 x 40mm screw **B**.



Step 10

Slide the front panel **8** into the slots of the two front rails.



Step 11

Slot the left-hand hinge of the lid **10** into the hole provided on the inside of the left side panel.
