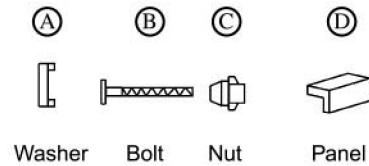
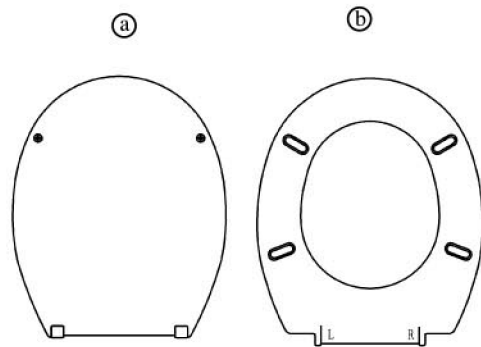


Living White Plastic Slow Close Toilet Seat

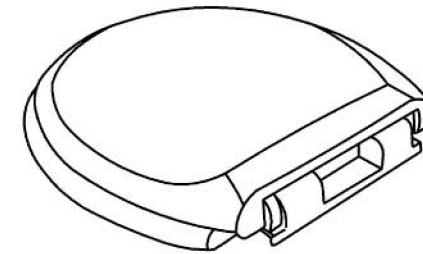


Hinge

IMPORTANT

1. Read these instructions carefully and familiarise yourself with the procedure before assembling the unit.
2. Check that you have all the component parts following the list on the back cover and familiarise yourself with each part before proceeding.
3. Take all the fittings out of the plastic bag and separate them into their groups.
4. Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly.
5. To avoid scratching it is recommended that you assemble the unit on a soft level surface.

Assembly Instructions

Stage 1 - Fitting the Support

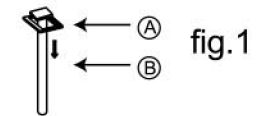

IMPORTANT: Before fitting this unit carefully check your Toilet bowl can match the parts and fittings of this unit and the Seat size matches your bowl size.

1. Insert the threaded fixing bolts (B) into the washer (A)

See fig. 1.

2. Insert the washer into the backside of hinge.

See fig. 2.

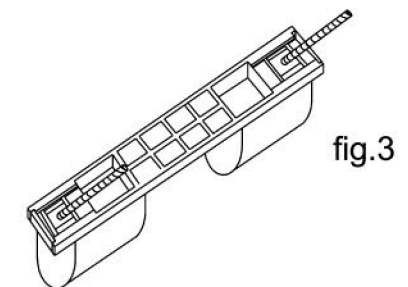

3. Adjust the bolt leftward and rightward until they are aligned with the holes in the toilet pan

4. Embed panel (D) on both sides of the hinge.

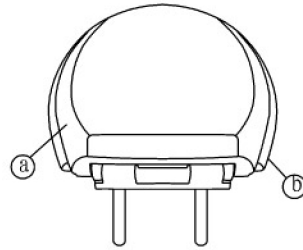

Assembly Instructions

Stage 2 - Fitting the Seat

1. Place the Toilet Seat on the toilet bowl ensuring the screws drop through the holes at the back of the bowl.

See fig. 5.



2. Centre the toilet seat on the bowl and ensure the Screws ② are well fitted.

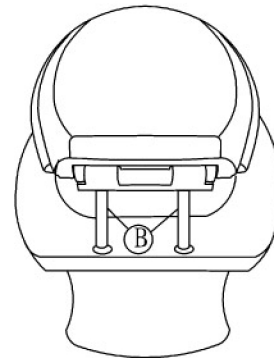

3. Use Plastic Nuts ③ to fix the Toilet Seat onto the bowl.

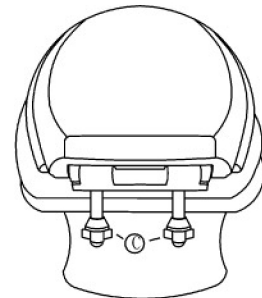

NOTE: Before use always make sure the unit is secure and the screws are tight.

Assembly Instructions

Stage 3 - Finishing the Unit

Soft Close:

- This Toilet Seat has Soft Close feature. It will close the Cover ① or Seat ② slowly. To close, gently pull the seat or cover forward and allow it to fall forward by itself, open in the normal way.

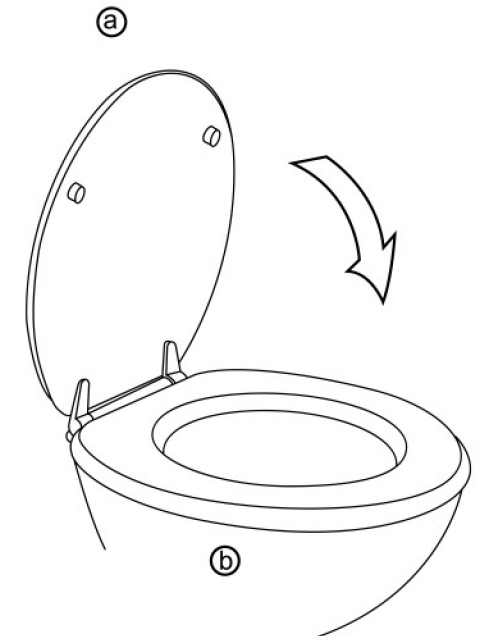
