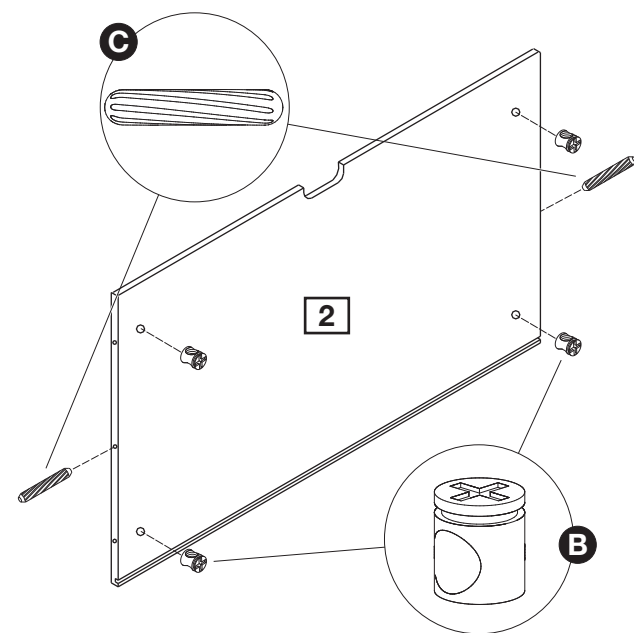


# Assembly Instructions

## Step 2

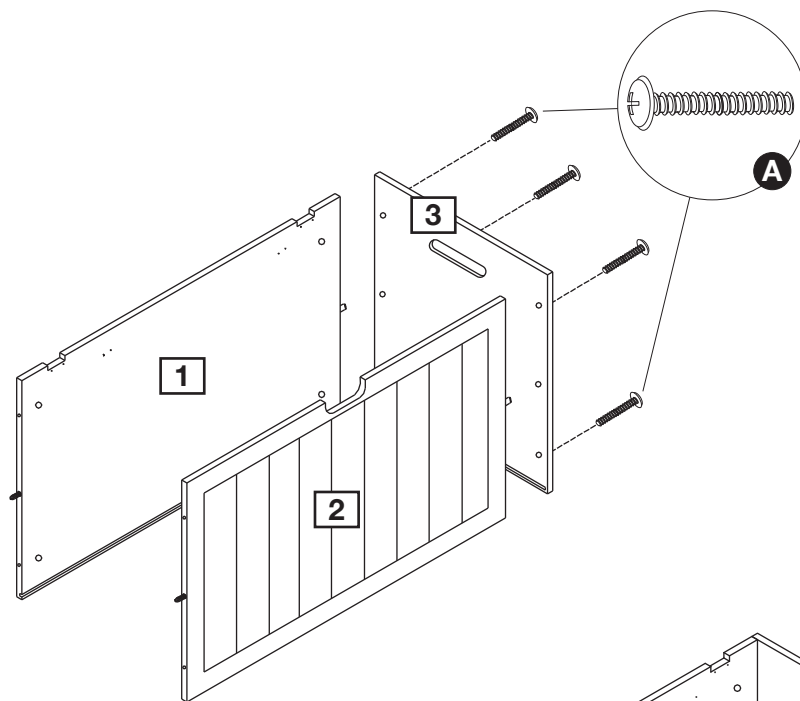
Insert 2 x 30mm wooden dowel **C** and 4 x connector **B** into the rear side of front panel panel **2** as shown.



## Step 3

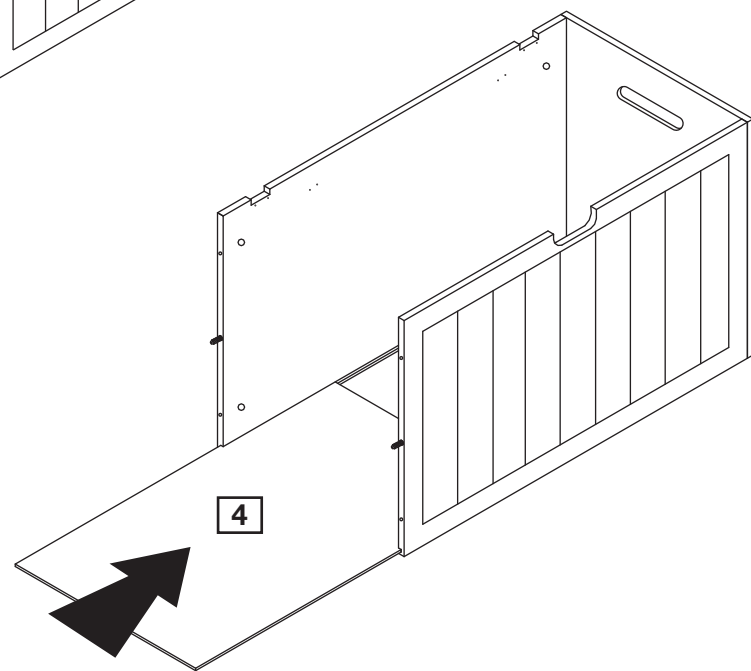
Connect one of the end panels **3** to front and back panels using 4 x 40mm bolt **A** as shown.

**Note:** ensure that the horizontal grooves in the panels are all at the bottom.



## Step 4

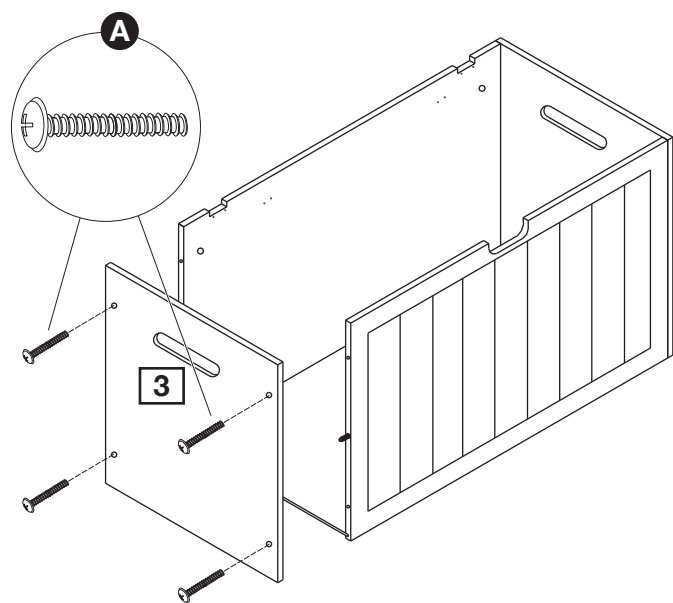
Slide the base panel **4** into the grooves at the bottom of the back and front panels as shown.



# Assembly Instructions

## Step 5

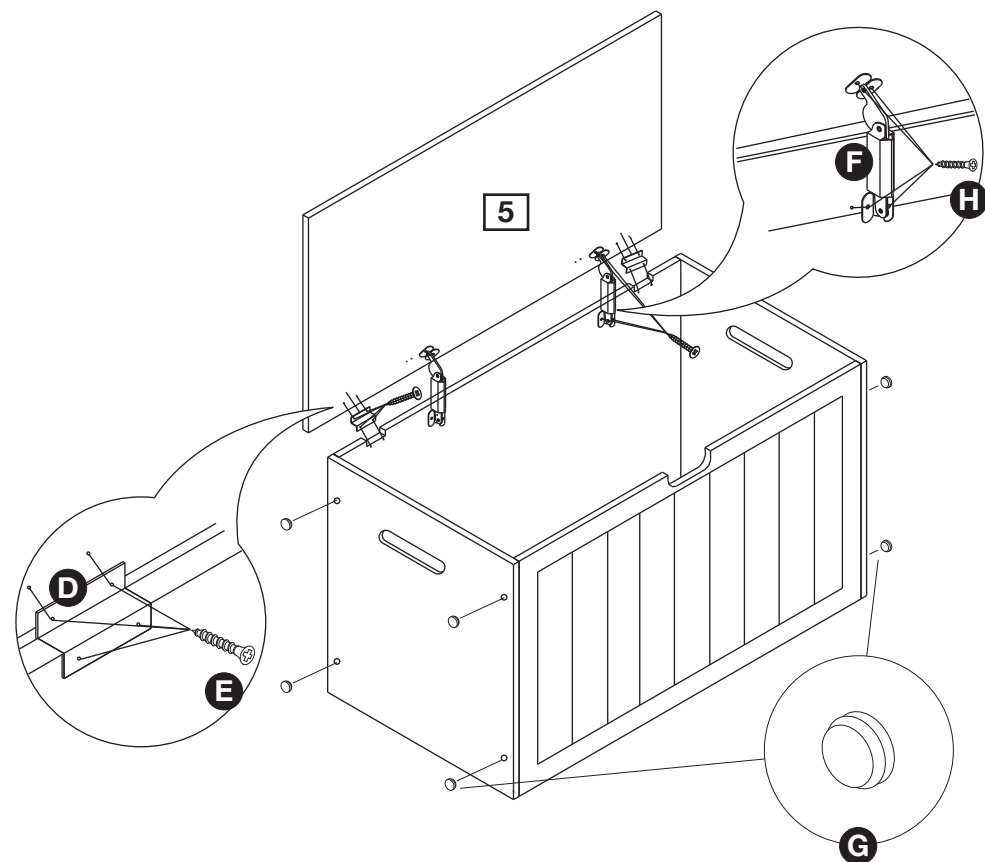
Connect the other end panel **3** to front and back panels using 4 x 40mm bolt **A** as shown.



## Step 6

Connect the lid **5** using 2 x hinge **D** and 8 x 14mm screw **E** to fix the hinges into place.

Connect the friction stays **F** to the under side of the lid and the inside of the box using 8 x 14mm screw **H** as shown.



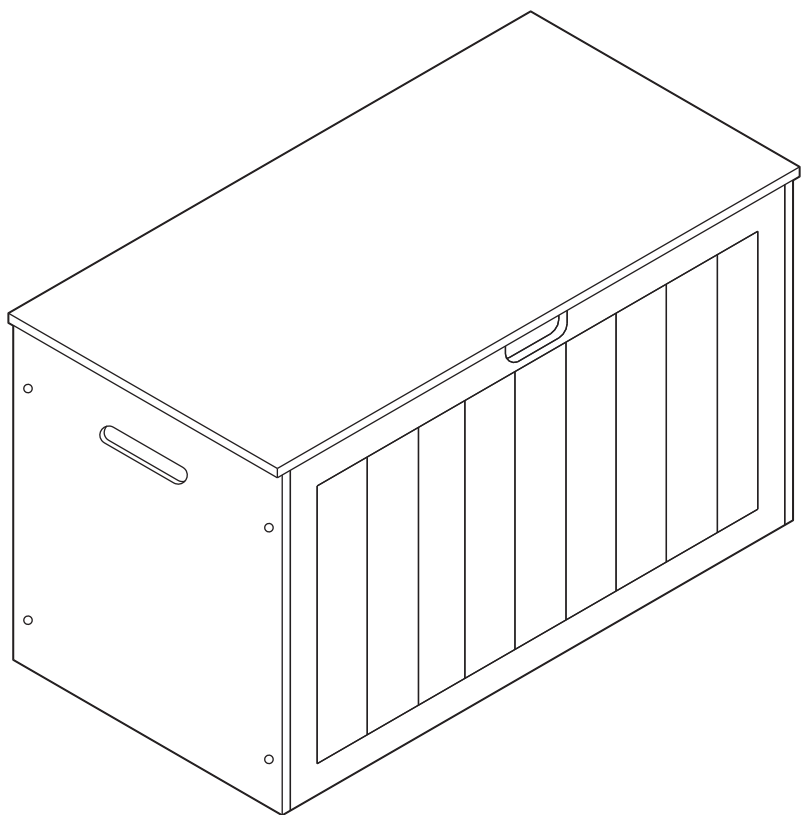
## Step 7

Insert a screw cover **G** into each of the screw holes to complete the unit.

## Safety and Care Advice

**Important** – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed opposite.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- Do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers **for inserting screws**, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

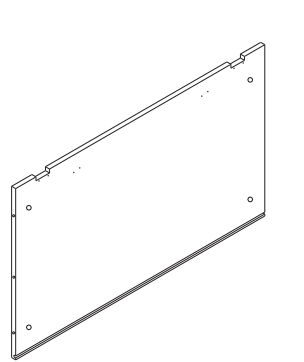
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

### Care and maintenance

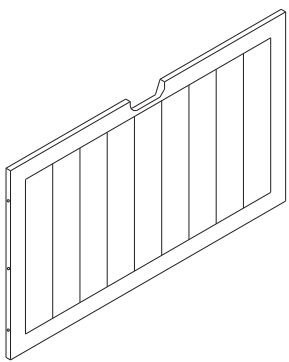
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

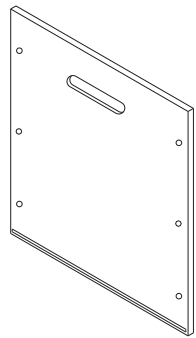

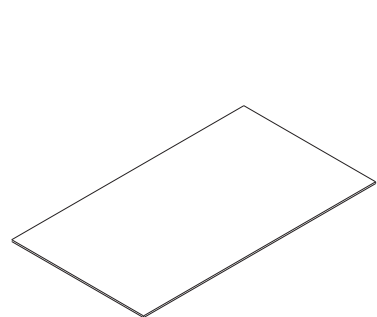
**1** Back panel x 1  
(43.5(h)cm x 71(w)cm)



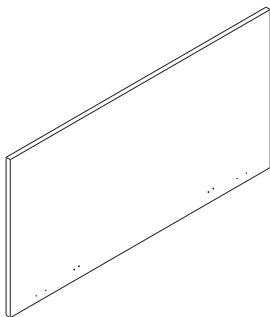
**2** Front panel x 1

(72(w)cm x 36.6(d)cm)











**5** Lid x 1

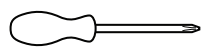

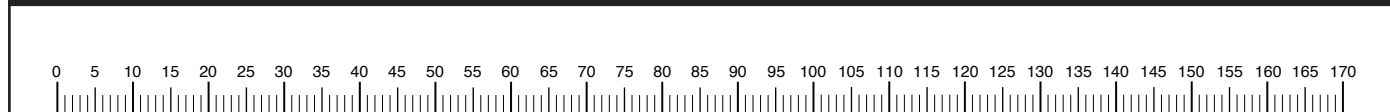
